Entry in the Laguna Legacy spearfishing competition and fundraiser includes a picnic, hot dog, soda, chips, t-shirt, the opportunity to win great raffle prizes, and awards for the top three participants. This is a family event for all to enjoy. Additional meet t-shirts are available if ordered and paid for by Aug. 15, 2010.

Date: Saturday, September 11, 2010

Meet Time: From 8:00 am to 1:45 pm. All fish entries must be presented for judging by the 1:45 pm deadline. All late catches will be disqualified.

Location: Aliso Creek at the fire pits. Look for our canopy and banner.

Cost: \$45.00 – Members of a California Spearfishing or Freediving Club
\$55.00 – All other divers.
\$60.00 – Registration on day of event (*t-shirt only while supplies last*)

Rules: The tournament will be a three fish contest and will follow the Nationals spearfishing rules and point system. The tournament is a scramble format within the Laguna Beach city limits. The top 3 participants with the highest points will receive an award. All state and local game/fish rules will apply. Competitors must possess a valid CA fishing license. All spearguns, including polespears, must be loaded using muscle power. No detonating or power heads may be used. Spearguns must be loaded and unloaded in the water and tips must be covered anytime on the beach. No free-shafts will be allowed. No chumming/baiting allowed at any time. Fish may only be taken while freediving. Scuba, hooka, or any other kind of breathing aid is not allowed. Red/White dive flag is mandatory. (Minimum size to be 14 x16 inches.) Divers must take their own fish. Paddleboards/kayaks or float propulsion shall be powered by manual methods only.

Failure to comply with meet rules will result in disqualification.

T-shirt

Deadlines: August 15, 2010

To be eligible for a commemorative t-shirt, registration and entry fee must be received by August 15, 2010

Entries received after August 15, 2010, will receive a t-shirt only while supplies last.

RULES

Fish Species:

No take (zero) sharks, rays, skates, mola mola, eels, finless fish (eels)

Length:

Minimum length for tournament fish: 14 inches

- Rockfish 10"/14" **(No Retention of Canary, Yelloweye, Cowcod and Bronzespotted)**

• Fish Quantity:

No more than three fish (3) fish total may be weighed in. Only one (1) fish per species may be weighed in.

Scoring is 1 (one) point per fish plus 1 (one) point per pound excepting that a single fish's points may not exceed 21 points (20 lb. plus 1 point for the fish). In the event of a tie, the participant with the largest fish (by weight) wins.

• Diving Areas:

The tournament boundaries are the Laguna Beach City Limits. Newport Beach to the North and Laguna Niguel to the South.
